## **BILLING:**

Academic Year = 10 months

Billing will occur monthly (unless you've already prepaid then see below).

The new tuition cost will be divided into monthly payments and be billed at the applicable Learning Program rate (see above).

Any payments already made have been credited to your account and will be applied to your balance due.

If you received a discount for paying in full, early enrollment and/or sibling discounts prior to the new contract, your total tuition will never exceed that amount.

Contract may be voided with a 30-day written notice of withdrawal and 1 additional monthly payment required.

**\*Morning Lesson and Practice/Track Class:**

1. Break times are aligned so that siblings can have the same breaks.
2. Class teachers are customizing grade schedules to build in:
  - movement activities & screen breaks
  - possible additional recess time or different start times
  - possible pre-recordings
  - one-on-one check-ins during their scheduled lesson with their classes based on the subject and the age and developmental level of their students.

**\*\*Specialty Lessons:**

1. Each class will receive its specific schedule.
2. One lesson per day is reserved for specialty subjects.
3. Class Teachers will cover this lesson time if no Specialty is scheduled.
4. The Specialty lesson might actually take place during Morning Lesson or Practice/Track.
5. Some Specialty Teachers might teach small groups for 15 or 20 minutes each. This will be scheduled accordingly.
6. If needed, one specialty lesson will be taught in the morning on "Finish Friday."
7. Some days might include 2 Specialties as an alternative to scheduling on "Finish Friday."
